POLAR CLIMATE

- Temperatures below 0°C
- No variation winter/summer
- Low rainfall

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• Landscape: Glaciers and tundra

HIGH MOUNTAIN CLIMATE

- Low temperatures
- Short, cool summers
- Heavy rains
- TEMPERATE ZONE GOLDZONE • Landscape: Alpine meadows

TROPICAL CLIMATE

- High temperatures
- No variation winter/summer
- Abundant rain in the summer
- Landscape: Savannah and rainforest

EQUATORIAL CLIMATE

- Very high temperatures
- No variation winter/summer
- Abundant rain all year round
- Landscape: Equatorial forest

Desert Climate

- High temperatures
- High variation night/day
- Very low rainfall

Landscape: Desert

- Extreme temperatures
- High variation winter/summer
- Low rainfall

MEDITERRANEAN CLIMATE

- Mild temperatures
- Hot, dry summers
- Seasonal rainfall
- Landscape: Mediterranean forest

OCEANIC CLIMATE

- Mild temperatures
- Little variation summer/winter
- Heavy rainfall
- Landscape: Temperate
- deciduous forest
